Summary: Projected shortage of 2 Million craft workers in next few years. Program in Alabama has increase high school CTE enrollment by 33%. Program paid for by self-imposed fee paid by contractors.

1. HB1179 by *Towns, *Cooper. (*SB1112 by *Kyle.)

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires department to utilize scale of 100 percent when reporting progress in the Tennessee report card for schools beginning with the report for the 2013-2014 school year. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

2. [HB2116](#) by *Brooks H. ([*SB1834](#) by *Gresham, *Niceley.)

Education, Higher - As introduced, limits courses state employees can take free of charge at public institutions of higher education under the state employees' fee waiver to 4 credit hours or 120 clock hours courses; allows the use of the fee waiver as partial payment for courses of more than 4 credit hours or 120 clock hours. - Amends TCA Section 8-50-114.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

3. [*HB2115](#) by *Brooks H, *White D. ([SB2423](#) by *Henry, *Summerville.)

Education, Higher - As introduced, prohibits the board of regents and the University of Tennessee's board of trustees from adopting policies that substantially burden students' free exercise of religion. - Amends TCA Title 4 and Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

4. [HB1780](#) by *DeBerry J, *White M. ([*SB1887](#) by *Gresham.)

Schools, Charter - As introduced, creates a 30 day application period for students eligible for the achievement school district to enroll in the charter school; allows additional students to enroll in the charter school as long as the student enrollment does not exceed the school's capacity. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 13.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

5. [HB1871](#) by *Coley. ([*SB1940](#) by *Johnson.)

Education, Curriculum - As introduced, requires every LEA required to provide family life curriculum to provide the department of education and the state board of education with a list of the specific curriculum used to teach the family life curriculum; requires the report to include the contact information of every individual, non-LEA employee or organization authorized to teach the family life curriculum. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 13.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

6. [*HB1777](#) by *Williams R. ([SB2535](#) by *Burks.)

Employees, Employers - As introduced, creates the Go Build Fund to attract students towards careers in the construction industry. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 49 and Title 50.

Status: Rolled 2 weeks.

7. [HB1857](#) by *Williams R, *Jernigan, *Pitts, *Dunn, *Brooks H, *DeBerry J, *Roach, *Akbari, *White M, *Coley, *Kane. ([*SB1692](#) by *Massey, *Gardenhire, *Tate, *Burks, *Crowe.)

Tennessee Higher Education Commission - As introduced, expands the duties of the executive director of THEC to ensure institutions develop and use electronic instructional materials and related information technology accessible to individuals with disabilities; creates the Accessibility Task Force to establish conformity with the director's new duties. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 2 and Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 20.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

8. [HB1942](#) by *Hawk. ([SB2063](#) by *Southerland.)

Education - As introduced, permits municipalities to extend the terms of local school board members in order to comply with the general law and synchronize local elections to the general election. - Amends TCA Section 49-2-201.

Status: Passed. Sent to Budget Sub-Committee. (Allows Greeneville schools to sync their school board election with general local elections.)

9. [HB2491](#) by *McCormick, *Brooks H, *White M, *Forgety, *Kane, *Coley. ([SB2471](#) by *Norris.)

Education, Higher - As introduced, enacts the "Tennessee Promise Scholarship Act of 2014"; revises certain provisions of the Tennessee HOPE scholarship program. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 7 and Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

10. [HB0203](#) by *Ramsey. ([SB1025](#) by *Overbey.)

Education - As introduced, encourages LEAs to work with area hospitals and doctors, as well as Project ADAM, a nonprofit organization serving children through life-saving programs that help prevent sudden cardiac arrest, in developing informational programs for faculty, staff and students on sudden cardiac arrest and in obtaining AEDs for LEA schools. - Amends TCA Title 49 and Title 68.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

11. [HB1658](#) by *Brooks K. ([SB1760](#) by *Ketron.)

Education - As introduced, prohibits counting walking to and from class towards the minimum of 90 minutes per week of required physical activity for public school students. - Amends TCA Section 49-6-1021.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

12. [HB1735](#) by *Sexton. ([SB2002](#) by *Massey, *Burks, *Gardenhire, *Overbey.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, defines dyslexia and requires in-service training for teachers and other training collaboration by the department of education with institutions of higher education concerning instruction related to dyslexia. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

13. [HB2049](#) by *Gilmore, *DeBerry J, *Casada, *Shepard. ([SB2246](#) by *Hensley.)

Education - As introduced, requires schools and LEAs to encourage various measures to limit students' exposure to harmful substances while at school. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

14. [HB2122](#) by *White M, *Ragan. ([*SB2354](#) by *Gresham, *Ketron.)

Education - As introduced, revises the provisions governing harassment, intimidation, bullying and cyber-bullying in elementary and secondary education, including requiring the LEA to update the anti-bullying policy annually; mandating the parents and students sign the policy; and requiring the posting of the anti-bullying policy in classrooms, cafeterias restrooms and school buses. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 45.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

15. [HB2217](#) by *Weaver, *Dunn, *Brooks H, *White D, *Moody, *Kane. ([*SB2073](#) by *Haile.)

Local Education Agencies - As introduced, defines as confidential, information relative to school safety plans; provides that meetings involving school safety plans are not subject to the open meetings laws. - Amends TCA Title 8; Title 10 and Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

16. [HB2246](#) by *Forgety. ([*SB2362](#) by *Gresham.)

Education, Higher - As introduced, regulates transfer pathways for transfer between public institutions of higher education. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 2.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

17. [*HJR0683](#) by *Watson, *McCormick.

General Assembly, Confirmation of Appointment - Allison Chancey, state board of education. -

Status: Rolled 1 week.

Education, Higher - As introduced, removes obsolete language concerning the terms of the public members of the board of regents; clarifies confusing language resulting from the change of name of the Tennessee technology centers to Tennessee colleges of applied technology. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

2. [HB2042](#) by *White M, *Brooks K, *Casada. ([*SB2197](#) by *Ketrn.)

Local Education Agencies - As introduced, allows credit for a local government, that appropriates funds for education for a nonrecurring expenditure evidenced by a written agreement with the LEA, when determining compliance with the local government's maintenance of local education funding requirements. - Amends TCA Section 49-3-314(c).

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee. (One time money still does not count toward maintenance of effort, but required to share with city and special school systems on ADA basis same as any other expenditure. Returns law to way it was prior to last year with exception of maintenance of effort provision)

3. [*HJR0545](#) by *DeBerry J.

General Assembly, Statement of Intent or Position - Recommends all school administrators, teachers, parents and students be educated about the potential health impact of heavy backpacks and take proactive measures to avoid injury. -

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

4. [HB1693](#) by *DeBerry J, *Brooks H, *White M. ([*SB1684](#) by *Gresham.)

Schools, Charter - As introduced, allows charter schools to contract with for-profit managers or operators. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 13.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

5. [*HB1781](#) by *DeBerry J. ([SB2041](#) by *Kelsey.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, allows principals, on behalf of individual schools, to apply to the commissioner of education for a waiver from certain policies and procedures of zero tolerance violations. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 10; Title 49, Chapter 13; Title 49, Chapter 15; Title 49, Chapter 2; Title 49, Chapter 5; Title 49, Chapter 50 and Title 49, Chapter 6.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

6. [*HB1959](#) by *DeBerry J. ([SB2338](#) by *Kelsey.)

Education - As introduced, allows parents to petition for restructuring of a school through the transformation or turnaround model subject to certain conditions. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed as Amended.

7. [*HJR0543](#) by *Pitts, *Johnson C, *Tidwell.

General Assembly, Directed Studies - Requests the department of education to study and report on ways local education agencies are implementing the requirements of TCA 49-6-1021, which requires 90 minutes of physical activity per week. -

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

8. [HB1978](#) by *Pitts. ([*SB2101](#) by *Finney .)

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires the department of education to provide a fiscal note detailing the financial impact of any proposed rule or policy. - Amends TCA Title 3 and Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee.

9. [HB2125](#) by *Pitts. ([*SB2370](#) by *Tate.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, specifies that the provisions regarding suspensions imposed by the director of schools for three days or less apply to suspensions of teachers. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee. (Treats tenured and non-tenured teachers the same with regard to suspensions)

10. [HB2479](#) by *Akbari, *Camper, *Hardaway, *Cooper, *Armstrong, *Miller, *Pitts, *Fitzhugh. ([*SB2561](#) by *Kyle.)

Education - As introduced, requires the state board of education, department of education and the office of research and education accountability to confer with other stakeholders and determine the best means of establishing a best practices clearinghouse that shall identify, develop and share best practices from models of education reform with K-12 public schools. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

11. [HB0927](#) by *Camper, *Pitts, *Odom, *Gilmore, *Fitzhugh, *DeBerry L, *Turner M, *Jernigan, *Jones, *Johnson G, *Love, *Stewart, *Powell, *Mitchell, *Ramsey. ([*SB1124](#) by *Kyle, *Burks, *Ford, *Crowe.)

Education, Curriculum - As introduced, expands definition of harassment and bullying in schools to include conduct based on actual or perceived demographic traits, requires review of anti-bullying policies at least once every three years, clarifies that such policies apply to students, school staff and volunteers. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

12. [*HB1889](#) by *Camper, *Akbari, *Turner J. ([*SB2288](#) by *Ford.)

Education - As introduced, requires an LEA revising its policy prohibiting harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyber-bullying, which was filed with the commissioner of education, to transmit the revised policy to the commissioner. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Taken off notice.

13. [*HB2212](#) by *Camper. ([*SB1843](#) by *Finney.)

Law Enforcement - As introduced, requires a school resource officer or other school security officer to report any incident involving the discharge of a Taser or other stun gun on school property in the same manner as officers do in the applicable jurisdiction when a service firearm is discharged. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 42.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee. (Requires law enforcement agency to have policy regulating use of taser and to provide training).

14. [*HB1992](#) by *Floyd, *Powell, *McCormick. ([*SB1951](#) by *Gardenhire.)

Education, Higher - As introduced, permits undocumented alien students who are Tennessee residents, who meet the academic requirements of HOPE scholarship and attend Tennessee schools for five years prior to graduating from high school, be charged in-state tuition at public institutions of higher education. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

15. [*HB2434](#) by *Carr J. ([*SB2552](#) by *Hensley.)

Education - As introduced, allows LEAs to promote a student who has missed the maximum number of school days pursuant to the LEA's attendance policy to be promoted to the next grade if the student successfully completes all academic course work. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 30.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee. (Amendment makes the bill, states student can be promoted if completed all course work even if student had excused absences exceeding number allowed by LEA).

16. [*HB1568](#) by *Casada, *Sargent. ([*SB1934](#) by *Johnson.)

Textbooks - As introduced, removes the requirement that textbook publishers contracting to supply textbooks furnish a bond. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 22.

Status: Taken off notice.

17. [HB2249](#) by *Casada, *Womick, *Butt, *Dunn, *Sargent, *White D, *Matheny, *Evans. ([*SB1602](#) by *Bell, *Gresham, *Stevens, *Yager, *Johnson, *Tracy, *Hensley, *Crowe, *Tate, *Ketrn.)

Textbooks - As introduced, restructures the textbook commission and the textbook selection process. - Amends TCA Title 4 and Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee. (Amendment 1 makes the bill. Provides for commission training, specific textbook review criteria, criminal violation if members violate code of ethics, adds term limit to two years, states textbooks must be available online for citizens to view prior to adoption.) (Amendment 2 removes language regarding “bias” in books. Amendment 3 changes number of appointments to 5 by the governor and 3 each from the speaker of the house and speaker of the senate).

Education - As introduced, requires all driver education courses to instruct students of the dangers and criminal penalties for texting while driving. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

19. [HB2497](#) by *Holt. ([*SB2501](#) by *Stevens.)

Students - As introduced, revises the provisions governing the student code of acceptable behavior and discipline. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

20. [*HB1793](#) by *Kane. ([SB1949](#) by *Campfield.)

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires the department to promulgate rules that set the frequency for special exemptions, for the purpose of conducting infrequent school-sponsored fundraisers, for food or beverages that do not meet certain federal nutrition standards. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee.

21. [*HB2331](#) by *Farmer. ([SB2491](#) by *Dickerson.)

Schools, Charter - As introduced, allows a charter management organization to conduct meetings of its board of directors by electronic communication, if a physical quorum is not present at the meeting location without the determination that a necessity exists. - Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 44, Part 1 and Title 49, Chapter 13.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

22. [HB1758](#) by *Haynes. ([*SB1813](#) by *Massey.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, allows teachers scoring "significantly above expectations" on each of their last 3 evaluations to petition the commissioner of education for a waiver of any requirement for the renewal of their licenses. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 5.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

23. [HB2264](#) by *Hawk. ([*SB2342](#) by *Bowling.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, prohibits the establishment of any rules, policies or guidelines to require the results from classroom observation evaluations to correlate with TVAAS statistical data. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee.

24. [*HJR0551](#) by *Forgety, *Marsh, *Lollar, *Womick.

General Assembly, Directed Studies - directs the department of education to conduct another stakeholder survey that permits stakeholders to express their honest and frank opinions about the Teacher Educator Acceleration Model (TEAM) and to suggest additional changes and refinements to TEAM to improve the evaluation model. -

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee.

25. [*HB1375](#) by *Forgety, *Rogers, *Marsh, *Lollar, *Womick. ([SB2240](#) by *Tracy.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, requires the state board of education to adopt rules, rather than policies, governing the issuance of educator licenses; prohibits an educator's license from being non-renewed or revoked based solely on student growth data. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1; Title 49, Chapter 2 and Title 49, Chapter 5, Part 1.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee.

26. [*HB1381](#) by *Forgety, *Rogers, *Marsh, *Lollar, *Womick, *McCormick, *Pitts, *Shepard, *Shaw, *Gilmore, *Camper, *Powell, *Johnson G, *Towns, *Cooper, *Favors, *Miller, *Mitchell, *Fitzhugh, *Turner M, *Armstrong, *Jernigan, *Tidwell, *Stewart, *Parkinson, *Keisling. ([SB1856](#) by *Crowe.)

Education - As introduced, requires the state board of education, with the assistance of the department of education, to promulgate by rule a salary schedule for licensed educators based on years of service and educational training. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1; Title 49, Chapter 2; Title 49, Chapter 3 and Title 49, Chapter 5.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

27. [*HB1421](#) by *McCormick. ([SB1625](#) by *Norris.)

Education - As introduced, removes outdated language that required the commissioner of education to develop a local salary schedule for each LEA for fiscal year 2004-2005 and that required LEAs to adopt a local salary supplement for fiscal year 2004-2005. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 3, Part 3.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

28. [HB2316](#) by *Sanderson. ([*SB2435](#) by *Crowe.)

Education - As introduced, creates a TVAAS study committee to review the methodology and nature of the statistical estimates produced by TVAAS. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week.

29. [*HB1894](#) by *Marsh. ([*SB2277](#) by *Dickerson, *Burks.)

Basic Education Program (BEP) - As introduced, clarifies \$100 out of \$200 be given to each teacher by August 1 so that the teacher may spend it at any time during that school year on instructional supplies as determined necessary by the teacher; requires LEA to send written explanation to education committees and commissioner for any noncompliance. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 3, Part 3.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee (Amendment changes payment date to October 31).

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, enacts the "Educator Respect and Accountability Act of 2014." - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to full committee. (Amendment makes the bill. States that a teacher's license cannot be revoked based in whole or part on student achievement growth data).

31. [*HB1843](#) by *Johnson G, *Jernigan, *Fitzhugh, *Pitts, *Jones. ([*SB2222](#) by *Kyle.)

Education - As introduced, grants the director of schools the ability to employ persons in positions for which no teaching license is required by year-to-year contracts; provided, the director provides such persons 15 days' notice of nonrenewal of the contract before the end of the contract period. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 2, Part 3.

Status: Failed.

32. [*HB1845](#) by *Johnson G. ([*SB1923](#) by *Finney .)

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires an annual charter school report to be posted on the web site of the department. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

33. [*HB1847](#) by *Johnson G, *Pitts, *Fitzhugh, *Jernigan, *Jones. ([*SB1926](#) by *Finney .)

Education, Dept. of - As introduced, requires the department to employ three technology student association advisors, one in each grand division, to assist chapters of the Tennessee technology student association and elementary and secondary educators in providing technology education to students. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1.

Status: Failed (Fiscal note of \$250,000).

34. [HB1849](#) by *Johnson G, *Faison, *Fitzhugh, *Jernigan, *Pitts, *Jones, *Womick, *Sparks. ([*SB1928](#) by *Finney .)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, requires that evaluations of teachers be based on student performance only in subjects that were tested and in which the teacher taught the students. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 1; Title 49, Chapter 2, and Title 49, Chapter 3.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

35. [HB1558](#) by *Ragan. ([*SB1453](#) by *McNally.)

Education - As introduced, removes requirement that the BEP review committee consider whether to include English as second language teachers in the BEP funding formula, because the review committee has recommended that such teachers be included in the formula and the senate and house of representatives have approved the inclusion. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled 1 week. (Possibly taking off notice because Oak Ridge issue resolved).

36. [HB2133](#) by *Ragan. ([*SB2311](#) by *McNally.)

Local Education Agencies - As introduced, allows LEA employees who are not teachers, but who accrue sick leave, to participate in the LEA's teacher sick leave bank. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 5, Part 7 and Title 49, Chapter 5, Part 8.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee. (Permissive on LEA to allow non-certified personnel to participate in sick leave bank).

37. [*HB2313](#) by *Ragan, *Rogers, *Powers, *Butt, *Calfee, *Keisling. ([SB2473](#) by *Norris.)

University of Tennessee - As introduced, requires the Howard H. Baker Jr. Center for Public Policy at the university to perform a study on the economic feasibility of creating and utilizing a statewide comprehensive energy policy. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 11; Title 49; Title 60; Title 64; Title 65 and Title 68.

Status: Passed. Sent to full committee.

38. [*HB2084](#) by *Love. ([SB2371](#) by *Tate.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, revises various provisions governing the guidelines and criteria for the annual evaluation of all teachers and principals. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

39. [HB2121](#) by *Dunn. ([*SB2257](#) by *Massey.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, provides that duty-free teacher time for instructional planning shall be allocated on an individual basis. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Rolled to final calendar.

40. [HB1543](#) by *Bailey. ([*SB1703](#) by *Niceley.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, requires that teachers and principals be evaluated using only student growth or achievement data of students the teachers and principals have taught or supervised, respectively; reduces the portion of the evaluation based on student growth or achievement data from 50 percent to 40 percent for teachers and principals with less than three years of such data. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Taken off notice.

41. [*HB1990](#) by *Powell. ([SB2280](#) by *Dickerson.)

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, revises the provisions governing the criminal background investigation of any applicant for teaching or child care positions. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 5.

Status: Taken off notice.

Students - As introduced, requires an LEA in which a student is transferring to another school to send the student's records, including disciplinary records, to the school to which the student transfers; requires an LEA from which a student is transferring to another LEA to send the student's records, including disciplinary records, to the LEA to which the student transfers; requires LEAs in transferring records to comply with FERPA. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Lottery, Scholarships and Programs - As introduced, allows a Tennessee student graduating from an out-of-state boarding school that is accredited by a member of the National Association of Independent Schools Commission on Accreditation to be eligible for Tennessee HOPE lottery scholarship, if the student meets all other applicable requirements for the scholarship. - Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 4, Part 9.

Teachers, Principals and School Personnel - As introduced, defines dyslexia and requires in-service training for teachers and other training collaboration by the department of education with institutions of higher education concerning instruction related to dyslexia. - Amends TCA Title 49.

Status: Passed as amended. Sent to calendar committee. (Amendment requires board of regents and UT to report to general assembly on how teacher programs are addressing reading disorders including dyslexia.).
